

BOARD OF DIRECTORS, NEWTON CENTRAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT

The Newton Central Appraisal District board of directors met in regular session at 6:00 p.m. on February 15, 2023, in the office of the Appraisal District at 109 East Court Street in the City of Newton, Newton County, Texas.

Present were Chairman Ron Hughes, Vice Chairman Charles Summers, and member Robert Kester (Secretary). Absent were Robert L (Luke) Smith and Joe Waldrum. Melissa Burks, Newton County Tax Assessor/Collector was present by phone.

Also, present were Chief Appraiser, Margie Herrin and Chief Deputy, Kathy Maier.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ron Hughes at 6:02 p.m.

There were no guests present and no public comments.

Motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting was made by Charles Summers, second by Robert (Bob) Kester. Motion was approved by unanimous vote.

Motion to approve financial statements and invoices for November and December 2022 was made by Charles Summers, second by Robert (Bob) Kester. Motion was approved by unanimous vote.

Motion to approve the moving of lines line-item monies to close the financial year for 2022 was made by Charles Summers, second by Robert (Bob) Kester. Motion was approved by unanimous vote.

The quarterly investment report was presented to the board of directors for review. No action was required.

Margie Herrin, Chief Appraiser told the board one employee had left, and one was coming February 16, 2023. Four employees were registered to attend the Pacs conference. She stated that she would be attending the TAAD conference. The value studies were in, and all the schools the CAD appraises for, were within the guidelines, and we were the only county in the area to accomplish this. Collection department took in over 3 million in taxes during the month of January 2023.

The next meeting was set for May 17, 2023.


Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Charles Summers, second by Robert (Bob) Kester. Motion was approved by unanimous vote.
